1. The two-day State Level Exhibition and Project Competition-2019 has been organized by the Science Wing of Directorate of Education in collaboration with Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan, UT Mission Authority under Innovation in Science Pursuit for Inspired Research (INSPIRE) Award Manak Scheme of the Department of Science & Technology, Ministry of Science & Technology, Govt. of India, New Delhi in the Auditorium of Govt. Girls Senior Secondary School, Port Blair on 31st January, 2019.
2. The Department of Education has organized 'Katchara Utsav' as cleanliness drive in all schools including private schools in A & N Islands on 10th February, 2019.
3. Govt. Senior Secondary School, Kadamtala, Middle Andaman have bagged the Wipro Earthian National Award 2018. The award was presented to the winner students and guide teacher of GSSS, Kadamtala along with 24 teams of schools and colleges across the country by Shri Azim Premji, Chairman of Wipro Ltd., in recognition of their sustainable thinking. First time, a Govt. School of the Education Department, A & N Administration has won the Wipro Earthian Award under biodiversity category.

The Directorate of Education in collaboration with the officials of Health Department has constituted a committee to provide assistance to all needy children to mitigate their mental stress and psychological pressure for students appearing in AISSCE & AISSE, 2019. Especially the students appearing for AISSE, 2019 for the first time may be more vulnerable to stress and strain.
5. Master Sayen Aktar Shaik of Class IX of GSSS Neil Island (Shahheed Dweep) from this UT has made his mark at 7th National Level Exhibition & Project Competition (NLEPC). His exhibit 'Plastic Cap Opener of LPG Cylinder' bagged the 2nd place. He was awarded a cash prize of Rs. 15,000/- and a laptop. Whereas the project 'Common Man's hot box' made by kumari. E. Shrivanthi of Class IX from GSSS, Haddo (Telugu Medium) got selected in the top 60 projects in the NLEPC which was held from 14th & 18th February, 2019 at IIT, New Delhi. The best 7 selected exhibits from the State Level Exhibition Project Competition under INSPIRE Award-MANAK 2019 were displayed in the NLEPC -2019.
6. 03 days Master Resource Person's Training Programme for GTT (Social Studies) from 14th to 16th February, 2019 organized by State Institute of Education, Port Blair in collaboration with TNSCERT, Chennai under Samagra Shiksha Abhiyan (SMSA), Port Blair at Teachers Home, Port Blair.
7. 17 member Island Yoga team has participated in the 64th SGFI National Yoga Championship held at Aurangabad, Maharashtra from 29th January, 2019 to 2nd February, 2019.

8. The officials of Education in coordination with Department of Sports & Youth Affairs and Andaman Chamber of Commerce conducted the Andaman Marathon which was held at Port Blair on 3rd February, 2019.
